



Welcome to our first Beer festival, we really hope you'll have a great time and enjoy some great local (and a few not so local) beers, ciders, sprits & other local produce.

Do let us have your feedback on the event and if you'd like to see this become a regular item on the Betws-y-coed calendar!

### How it works!

All beers and other items for sale outside or on the stalls in our restaurant are available by token only (e.g. no cash is accepted). Tokens are available to purchase in the restaurant or at the stand in the corner of the car park and are priced at £1.80 per token – if you want to pay by card then you'll need to use the point in the restaurant.

All beers are priced the same (except at the main bar which works as normal accepting cash & card) – 1 token for a half (e.g. £1.90) or 2 tokens for a pint (e.g. £3.80). Other items are priced 'in tokens' e.g. as a multiple of £1.90.

There is no entrance fee for the festival, however we do have festival glasses available for purchase. These are £2.50 per glass, and can be returned at the end of the festival for a £1 refund and are available at the token points. No glasses are available at the outside/restaurant stands, so you will either need to purchase one of our glasses, bring your own or buy a drink from the main bar and re-use the glass. The main reason for this is to reduce the amount of glass that gets broken and left both on the property and the local area. We don't want to have to use plastics in future!

### The beers

#### Conwy brewery

**Welsh Pride** (Cask) – 4% Copper coloured Bitter – Orange, citrus/malt aroma with sweet, malty/nutty finish

**Clogwyn Gold** (Cask) – 3.6% Golden Hoppy Ale – Tropical fruit aromas followed by sweet malts & a gentle bitter/hoppy after taste

**San Francisco** (Cask) – 5.5% American IPA – Very hoppy with citrus hop followed by malty/biscuit flavours & a long satisfying bitter finish

**Irish Red** (Cask) – 4.3% Roasted Red Traditional Irish beer

#### Wild horse

**Buckskin Blonde** (Cask) - 4.5% American Blonde Ale with European twist – made with British lager malt and a late addition of Czech hops to deliver a light and refreshing blonde ale with a crisp satisfying finish.

**Palomino Pale Ale** (Cask) - 5.4% American Pale Ale – made with a generous amount of cascade & chinook hops. Expect citrus fruit and pine with a dry bitter finish

**Dry Hopped American Wheat** - 4.7% - This is not your typical wheat beer – a half-barley malt, half-wheat malt base is elevated by a generous load of West Coast hops, finished with a Mosaic dry-hop. The result is a light, refreshing beer with a big hit of tropical fruit.

**Noble Intentions** - 4.8% - A collaboration with our friend Geipel Brewing, this Düsseldorf style altbier was brewed with noble intentions to a historical recipe. But we couldn't resist putting a Wild Horse slant on things with small additions of Amarillo post-boil and as a dry-hop.

#### Sandstone brewery

**Sandstone edge** (Cask) – 3.8% - An aromatic session beer. A pale straw appearance carries a light bitterness and body to the aftertaste.

**Quaddrohppier** (Cask) – 4.4% - Four distinct hops sourced from around the globe combine to make a clean tasting blonde beer.

**Postmistress** (Cask) – 4.4% - A russet brown premium bitter – a union of 3 hops: Goldings, Fuggles and Styrian Goldings

**Onyx Dragon** (Cask) – 4% - A mysterious dark beer with hints of chocolate, toffee and caramel.

#### Purple Moose Brewery

**Madog Ale** (Keg) - 3.7% Vol – Bitter - A crisp, malty, amber coloured session bitter with a dry bitter finish.

**Glaslyn ale** (Keg) - 4.2% Vol – Premium Bitter - A golden coloured fruity best bitter with a well-balanced hoppy finish.

**Snowdonia ale** (Cask) - 3.6% Vol - Golden Pale Ale - A thirst quenching golden bitter brewed with a delicate combination of aromatic hops.

**Antlered IPA** (Bottled) - 5.2% Vol – India Pale Ale - An amber coloured, moreish IPA.

**Ysgawen** (Bottled) Elderflower Ale - 4.0% Vol - Pale Ale - A delightfully refreshing pale ale brewed using Cascade hops with elderflowers.

**Dark side of moose** (Bottled) - 4.6% Vol - Dark Bitter - A delicious dark ale with a deep malt flavour from roasted barley

**Chocolate moose** (Bottled) - 4.5% Vol – Stout - Chocolate & Vanilla Stout: A beer? A dessert? A dessert beer? Moose meets chocolate!

**Mwsh** (Bottled) - 4.7% Vol – Kölsch Style Lager - *We've used German Hersbrucker and Blanc hops, and lager malt.*

Other beers – **Old Speckled Hen** and **Abbot Ale** are available on the main bar as well as a range of other mainstream drinks

#### Ciders

A dry, medium and sweet cider from Dee ciders in North Wales – all 6%
